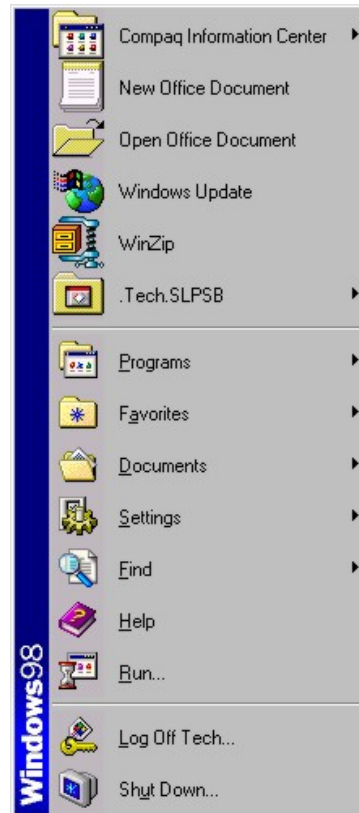


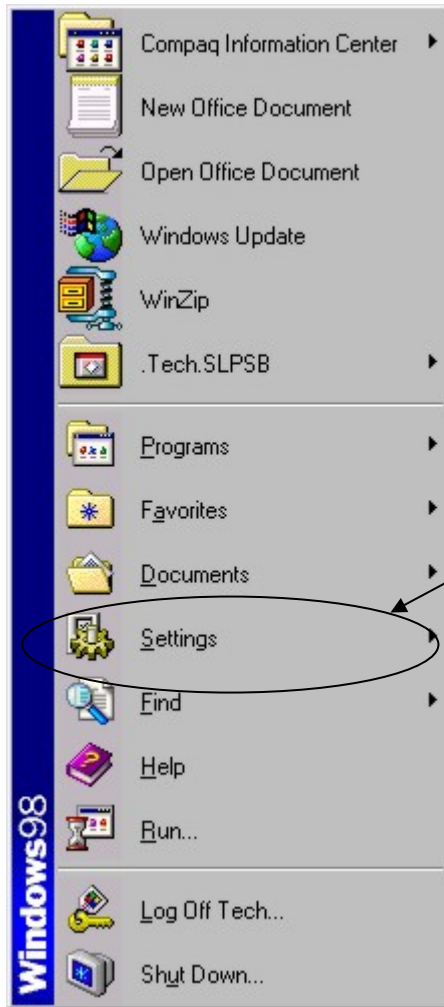
# How to Change the Name of a Windows 98 Computer

# Click the Start Button

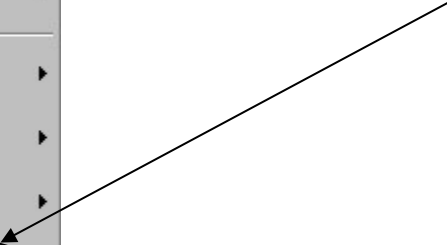


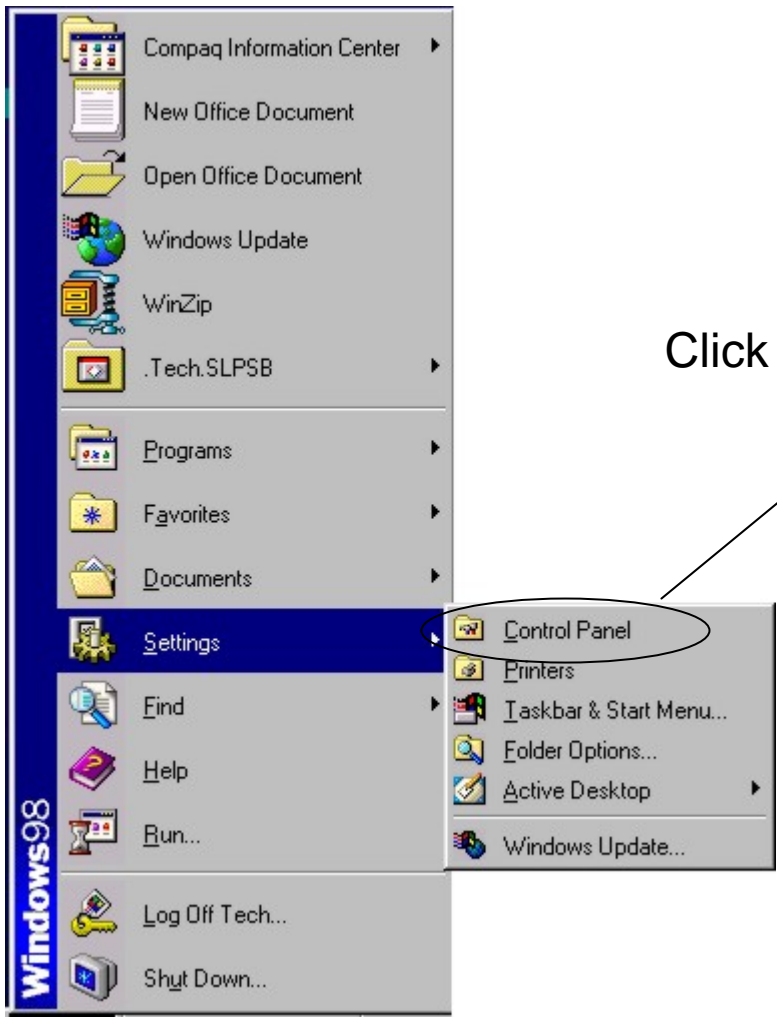
You should see this menu



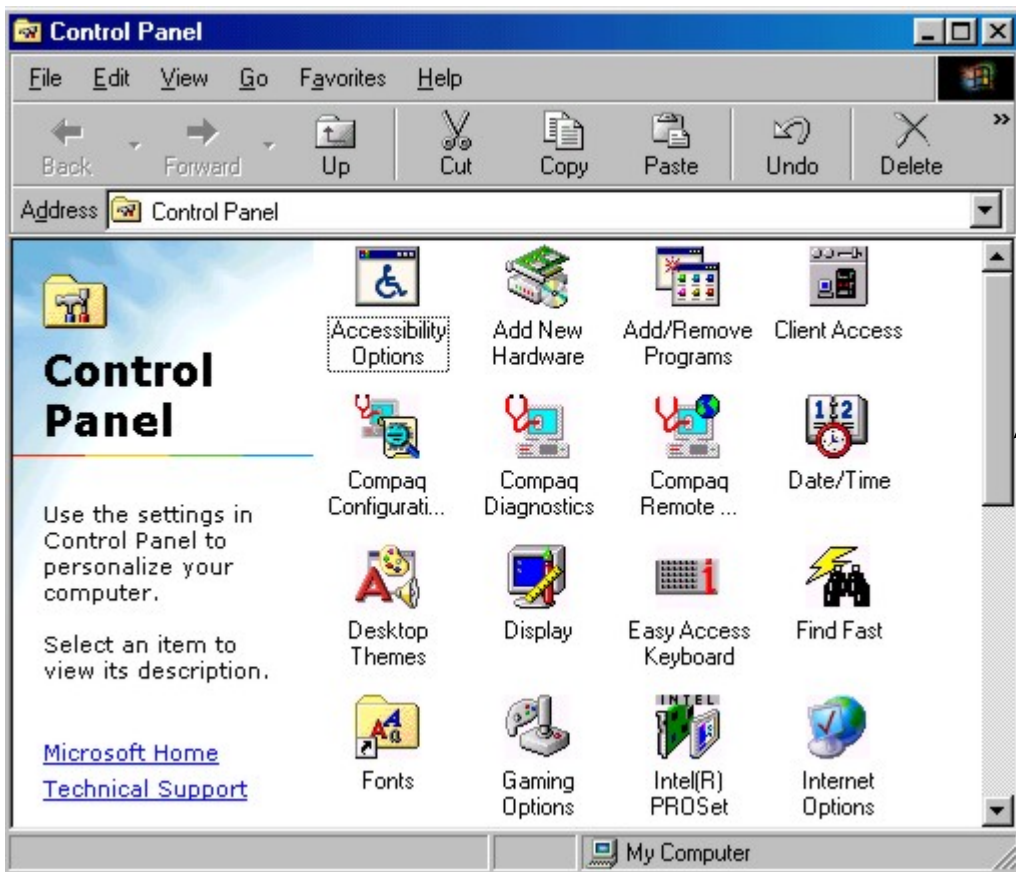


Click on Settings

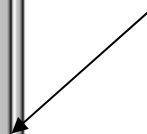


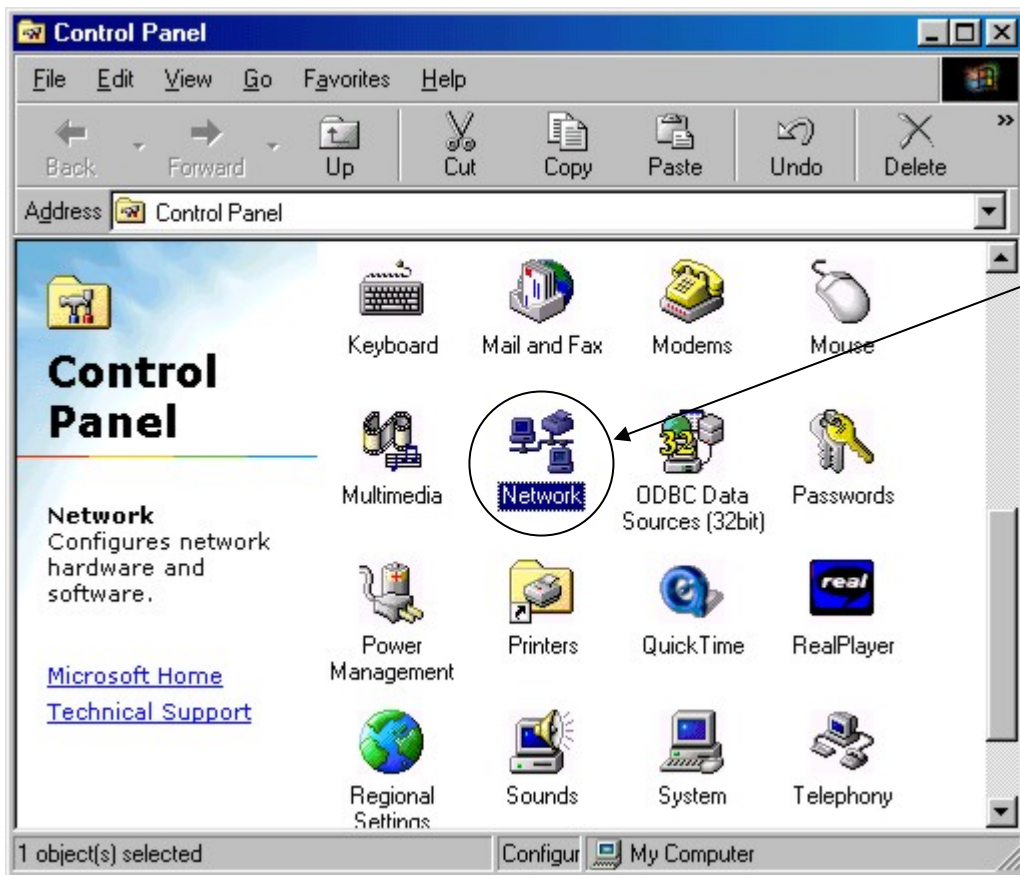


Click on Control Panel



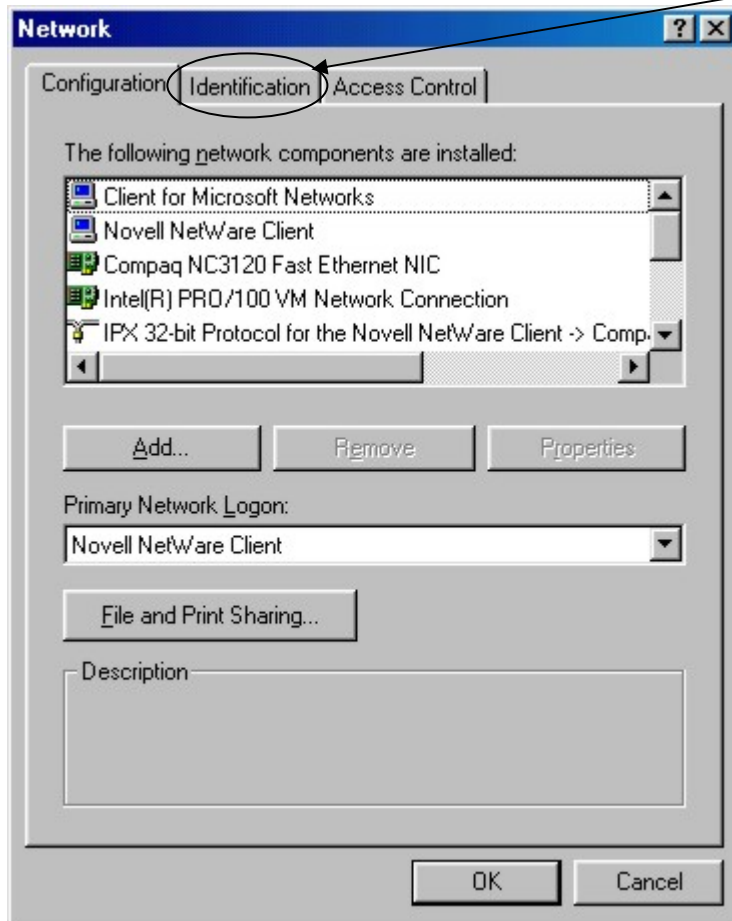
Use the scroll bar to scroll down to Network, if you have to.

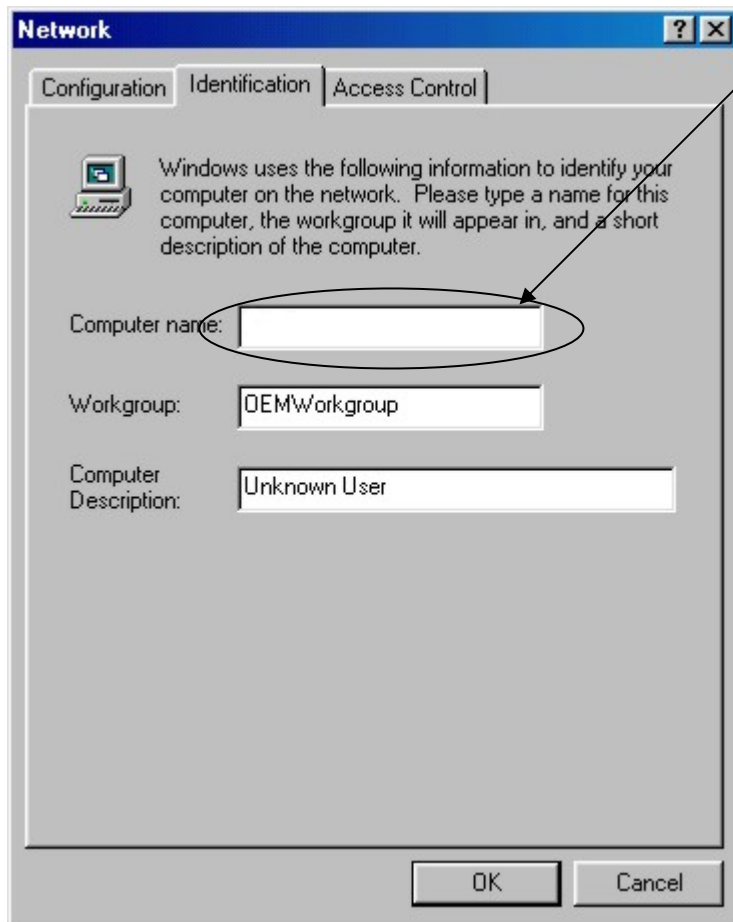




Double Click on the Network icon.

Click on the Identification tab





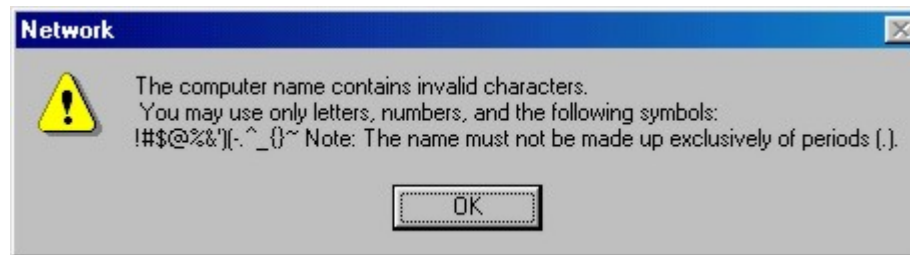
Type Computer Name Here.  
Use the format: XXX-YYY-ZZZ  
Where XXX is your school number  
For instance 002 = Arnaudville Elem.  
and YYY is your Fixed Asset room #  
(Again use leading zeros like 001).  
ZZZ is the number of the computer in  
your classroom. (001, 002 ...)

So the first computer at Arnaudville  
Elem. in Fixed Asset room # 44 would  
have a Computer Name like  
002-044-001

Fixed Asset room numbers can be  
obtained from the principal.

Then click OK

If you type in a character that is not allowed in a computer name you will get this warning message when you click OK. Please use only Letters (A-Z and a-z), number (0-9) and the dash (-).



After you have successfully changed the name of your computer you will see the message. Click Yes
